

Natural Gas Water Heating

In fact, a 40-gallon conventional gas water heater actually produces more hot water than a 50-gallon conventional electric system. With fast heat-up, a natural gas system requires less time and storage to keep the hot water running.

Conventional natural gas water heaters heat water twice as fast as electricity. That means you don't have to wait as long for the system to recover before you can use more hot water. It also means you can do the dishes, wash the clothes, and bathe the kids - all at the same time.

Natural gas is the cleanest-burning fossil fuel. Conventional and tankless gas heaters emit 3.5-4 tons less carbon dioxide per year than conventional electric systems, where electricity is produced by fossil fuel-fired power plants.
